## **BACKGROUND:**

On June 2, 2020, the Governing Board assigned the Administrative Committee the task of working though fund balance to identify appropriate uses of reserves.

The Administrative Committee met on June 23, 2020. At this Committee meeting, staff was directed to identify strategies that allow for fleet replacement in accordance with a revised fleet replacement schedule.
